

In Photography 7, 8 and 9, students will have the opportunity to use the DSLR cameras that are owned by Nose Creek School. Using the technology provided by the school is a privilege and a responsibility.

There will be strict guidelines regarding camera use during Photography class. If any of these rules are broken, students will lose the privilege of using the school DSLRs and will have to complete assignments with iPads or other personal devices.

- Treat all equipment with respect this means be gentle with the cameras, cords, battery packs, etc.
- You (or with a partner) will be assigned a camera. You must always use the camera you have been assigned.
- Always wear the camera strap. This ensures that the camera will not be dropped and broken.
- Keep track of all pieces such as battery packs, lens caps, SD cards etc. Lost or damaged items may result in you needing to replace the items or loss of use of the camera.
- If your battery goes to below 2 bars, please let your teacher know so it can be charged before next class.
- Do not delete photos from the camera that aren't yours other classes use these cameras, and we do not want to get rid of their work. There will be serious consequences if this happens.
